



MIGRANT SERVICES

PURPOSE

The Settlement Engagement and Transition Support (SETS) and the Community Action for a Multicultural Society (CAMS) programs aim to help new or existing Migrants who live in the Bundaberg area and need assistance with settlement or general access to services.

Our **Multicultural Youth Connections program** aims to provide support to youth (15-25 years old) from Culturally and Linguistically Diverse backgrounds to ensure they are not socially isolated.

ELIGIBILITY

To access SETS and CAMS services, you must be:

- a migrant, refugee or asylum seeker; *or*
- on a humanitarian, refugee, or family visa, or other eligible visa; *or*
- from a Culturally and Linguistically Diverse (CALD) background.

Please note there are no Visa restrictions to access our **Multicultural Youth Connections program**.

DESCRIPTION

What can our Migrant Services do for you?

- Provide you with advice and referrals to other services and agencies
- Help with citizenship and permanent residency applications
- Support you when dealing with other services and agencies
- Provide you with information sessions and workshops
- Help you connect with English language classes
- Help you connect with community and other social and cultural groups
- Offer a Playgroup for families with children up to 5 years old
- Other services may be available on request.

Through the **Multicultural Youth Connections program** our goal is to help youth:

- feel like they belong
- be involved in safe social activities
- play sport
- consider their employment and career goals, and how to achieve those aspirations
- by offering services or connection to services that they need.
