Centre Programs

MIGRANT SERVICES

Settlement Engagement and Transition Support (SETS) Program

- To promote and assist self-reliance for eligible new migrants in Bundaberg regional area
- General settlement information – available in own language
- Referrals to agencies and other service providers
- Practical support, assistance and advocacy
- Help in domestic violence situations
- Information, education and training workshops

Community Action for a Multicultural Society (CAMS) Program

- Information and referral services
- Culturally And Linguistically Diverse (CALD) community development and advocacy assistance
- CALD group assistance to develop and deliver community projects and cultural events
- Provide connections to other government and non-government organisations in the region
- Free professional development presentations on engaging with and providing culturally inclusive services to CALD clients

Multicultural Youth Connections

- Provide support to youth (15-25 years old) from Culturally and Linguistically Diverse backgrounds to ensure they are not socially isolated

Centre Programs

No Interest Loans (NILs) Program

- Provides interest-free small loans to eligible persons on low incomes
- Loans available for basic household appliances (e.g. fridge), furniture, car-related items, educational items or medical aids
- Low repayments via Centrepay, direct deposit and direct debit
- **NO loans** for household bills, rental bonds, debt consolidation, etc
